

Hanover Township Landmark Commission

Meeting Minutes

April 23, 2019

1. Chairman Czuchnicki called the meeting to order at 7:10 pm. Members Present: B. Blumenfeld, R. Conte, M. Czuchnicki, L. Fariello, A. Loughlin, P. Petrillo, M. Sieka, Liaison B. 2. Reading of Minutes – Chairman Czuchnicki asked if there were any changes to the meeting minutes if not is there a motion to approve the meeting minutes. Member Blumenfeld made a motion to approve the meeting minutes. Member Conte seconded the motion. All members were in favor.
