

## FREE TREE GIVE-AWAY

Hanover Township is again supporting the Free Tree Give-Away for the fall of 2018. There are 100 trees available to **the first 100 Hanover Township residents who send in their completed forms**. You must be a Hanover Township resident to be eligible and it must be planted in Hanover Township. ONLY one tree per family per address, please. Whether sent by mail or e-mail, all forms must be received at the Municipal Building before 4:00 PM on Thursday, October 11<sup>th</sup> to be eligible.

Trees can be picked up at a local nursery. If the resident cannot pick up the tree, then a delivery option and planting option are available. These would have to be the responsibility of the resident.

Each winner will be mailed a certificate and be required to pick up their tree by November 30<sup>th</sup>. The tree measures 4' – 6' in height and will be in a lined container. Any tree not picked up before the end date will be forfeited and awarded to someone else. Each winning resident is responsible for picking up, properly installing and maintaining the tree. There will be no replacement of failed trees. Careful thought should be given to the location where you plant the tree. Considerations include township setbacks, easement, the presence of overhead utilities, in ground service, pavement and proximity to structures of any kind. The plants being offered are trees, not shrubs and in maturity will require space to grow; the location should be chosen with the future in mind.

### TREE DESCRIPTION

#### **Kwanzan cherry**

The Kwanzan cherry has a double pink attractive flower. It grows in a symmetrical canopy and will achieve a height range of 15-25 feet. It prefers loose soil and well- drained soil. It has yellow fall colors. This tree is glorious in flower.

#### **Yoshino cherry**

The Yoshino cherry is the darling of the flowering tree world and the star of such renowned events as the National and International Cherry Blossom Festivals. This stand-out tree is, of course, known for its vibrant display of white-pink blossoms and faint almond fragrance in the springtime. In the summer, this tree will be a highlight in the yard with its oriental branching pattern, glossy bark and dark green leaves.

It is typically planted for both its visual interest and profusion of spring flowers.
