All loud and unnecessary noise, including the playing of any musical instruments, is strictly prohibited after the hour of 10:00 p.m. (Sections 182-2. and 184.3. of the Code of the Township).

Block Party participants are responsible for the collection of litter and the proper disposal of items in accordance with the Township's sanitation and recycling regulations (Chapter 154 of the Code).
