The Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

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The Township Committee reserves the right to award a contract to the successful vendor in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1 of the Local Public Contracts Law and the “Fair and Open” process as set forth in the Pay-to-Play Legislation at N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7, or, at its discretion to reject all competitive proposals and quotations.
