Vaccines for Adults

The Hanover Township Health Department now offers vaccinations for adults. People who do not have insurance or who have insurance that does not cover certain vaccinations can get them at the Health Department for little or no cost. This program is funded through New Jersey Department of Health with federal funds from the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and is called "Vaccine for Adults".

The vaccines available include: Tdap(Tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis prevention), **Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Zostavax** (Shingles prevention) and **Pneumococcal** (pneumonia prevention).

Who: NJ residents 18 years of age and older can get these vaccinations from the Health Department in Hanover.

How: Contact the Hanover Township Health Department to schedule an appointment at 973-515-6667.

Cost: Free for Hanover, Morris Township and Harding residents.
