- Reviewed Garden Air, LLC, Hangar 18 Morristown Municipal Airport Airport Road, Block 6501, Lot 1 multi-permit for an Individual Freshwater Wetlands Permit, Flood Hazard Area Permit, and Flood Hazard verification. All members reviewed the application. The Environmental Commission had no comment with this application.
- Reviewed Freshwater Wetlands Permit Application Cedar Knolls Road R.O.W. from South Jefferson Road to approx.. 170 ‘ west of the Whippany River, South

Jefferson Road R.O.W. from Cedar Knolls Road to the Whippany River General Permit Authorization. Member Steiger said that this application was for the trails. Member Steiger said that he heard that the bids came in too high and they will have to rebid it. Liaison Gallagher said there are a lot of moving parts before it all comes together. The Environmental Commission had no comment with this application.

- Adopt-A-Spot – Liaison Gallagher said that this week the island next to the municipal building will have a new berm created. Liaison Gallagher said that Member Iannaccone and Ron are working on a water source for the island.
