



NOTICE

In order to serve you better, The Southeast Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority (the “Authority”) will be upgrading the water system in your area between February 12, 2018 and March 2, 2018.

The service area improvements will affect the area outlined on the attached map. The improvements will be implemented in phases in targeted areas of the defined service area, as defined below and as outlined on the map.

Improvement Phases:

Phase 1 (February 12, 2018 to February 16, 2018): Beech Drive, Court Road, Hickory Drive, Lindstrom Road, Old Wood Road, Parker Drive, Poplar Drive, Simons Drive and Stanford Court.

Phase 2 (February 19, 2018 to February 23, 2018): Apple Tree Ln, Locust Dr, Orchard St and Poplar Dr.

Phase 3 (February 26, 2018 to March 2, 2018): Cedar Run, Countrywood Drive, Crest Drive, Cypress Avenue, Evergreen Lane, Forest Drive, Hickory Place, Larch Road, Linden Way, Manger Road, McNabb Road, Palm Court, Slope Drive and Sycamore Terrace.

What to Expect:

During this time, you may experience minimal changes in water pressure and/or discolored water for a short period of time where these observations may be observed within, or outside of, the areas defined for each phase.

Customer Tips:

- If discolored water occurs, simply run the cold water for a few minutes until it clears. This will allow the sediment to work its way out of your pipe.
- Check for discolored water before using the washing machine or dishwasher. Wait until the water runs clear before doing laundry or running the dishwasher. NOTE: If your laundry does become stained, do not put your laundry into the dryer. Re-wash laundry immediately and add a rust remover.
- In some cases, slight discoloration might linger for a few hours. This discoloration affects the appearance of the water and does not affect water quality. No health hazards are associated with discolored water from this upgrade.
