During the last 30 years, Hanover Township has witnessed the development of over 1,800 condominium units, single family residential and apartments, and there is the potential for more. Much of this housing has been developed in response to enforcement of the “Mount Laurel doctrine” by the Courts and the New Jersey Legislature.
