

FEMALE CANCER SCREENING

The American Cancer Society guidelines for early detection of cervical cancer recommend women ages 21-65 receive a pelvic exam and Pap test every three years. Clinical breast exam (CBE) is recommended every 3 years for women in their 20 and 30's and every year for women 40 and over. Yearly mammograms are recommended beginning at age 40.
