

ORDINANCE NO. 11-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 267-26. ENTITLED “BUS STOPS.” AND SECTION 267-51. ENTITLED “SCHEDULE XXI: BUS STOPS.” UNDER CHAPTER 267 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC BY AUTHORIZING THE DESIGNATION OF NEW BUS STOPS ALONG PORTIONS OF NORTH JEFFERSON ROAD, SOUTH JEFFERSON ROAD AND CEDAR KNOLLS ROAD, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(e)

WHEREAS, New Jersey Transit has requested the designation of new bus stops along portions of North Jefferson Road, South Jefferson Road and Cedar Knolls Road in order to support the restructuring of local bus services within Morris County; and

WHEREAS, the Business Administrator, Chief of Police and Township Engineer met with representatives of New Jersey Transit on October 20, 2010 to discuss and review safety issues; and

WHEREAS, as a result of that meeting, and a subsequent on-site inspection of the proposed bus stop locations with New Jersey Transit’s Bus Stop Sign & Shelter Programs’ Field Representative, the Chief of Police and Township Engineer are satisfied that the new bus stop locations will not pose a threat to the safety of pedestrians or motorists; and

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police and Township Engineer, the Township Committee concurs with the designation of new bus stops as set forth above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(e) and Section 267-26. entitled “Bus Stops.” under Chapter 267 of the Code of the Township entitled Vehicles and Traffic, Section 267-51. “Schedule XXI: Bus Stops.” Under Article V, “Schedules” is hereby amended and supplemented with the designation of new bus stops along portions of the following Township roadways:

A. Along South Jefferson Road, northbound on the easterly side thereof at:

- i. Between Cedar Knolls Road and Eden Lane – Mid-block
Beginning 367 feet north of the northerly curb line of Cedar Knolls Road and extending 135 feet northerly therefrom. (At #115 Jefferson Plaza.)
- ii. Between Eden Lane and Cedar Knolls Road – Mid-block
Beginning 1,000 feet of the southerly curb line of Eden Lane and extending

135 feet southerly therefrom. (At building #91.)

- iii. Rosin Road - Near Side
Beginning at the southerly curb line of Rosin Road and extending 105 feet southerly therefrom. (Opposite the U.S. Postal Service Facility.)
- iv. Apollo Drive - Near Side
Beginning at the southerly curb line of Apollo Drive and extending 105 feet southerly therefrom. (At Stephen Gould Corporation.)

B. Along South Jefferson Road, southbound on the westerly side thereof at:

- i. Rosin Road - Far Side
Beginning from the prolongation of the southerly curb line of Rosin Road and extending 100 feet southerly therefrom. (At the Postal Facility.)
- ii. Between Eden Lane and Cedar Knolls Road - Mid-block
Beginning 919 feet south from the southerly curb line of Eden Lane and extending 135 feet southerly therefrom. (At building #100.)
- iii. Between Cedar Knolls Road and Eden Lane - Mid-block
Beginning 376 feet north of the northerly curb line of Cedar Knolls Road and extending 135 feet northerly therefrom. (At #110 Jefferson Plaza.)

C. Along North Jefferson Road, northbound on the easterly side thereof at:

- i. Between Paper Mill Drive and Route 10 - Mid-block
Beginning 157 feet south of the southerly curb line of Paper Mill Drive and extending 135 feet northerly therefrom. (Near The Grande at Hanover Townhouses.)
- ii. Between Fanok Road and Stoney Brook Road – Mid-block
Beginning 170 feet south of the southerly curb line of Fanok Road and extending 135 feet southerly therefrom. (At Halo Pharmaceutical.)

D. Along North Jefferson Road, southbound on the westerly side thereof at:

- i. Between Fanok Road and Windemere Court – Mid-block
Beginning 100 feet south of the southerly curb line Fanok Road and extending 135 feet southerly therefrom. (At Hanover DPW.)
- ii. Town Hall Drive - Far Side
Beginning at the southerly curb line of Town Hall Drive and extending 100 feet southerly therefrom. (At The Hanover Campus.)

E. Along Cedar Knolls Road, eastbound on the southerly side thereof at:

- i. Jori Lane - (Near side)
Beginning at the westerly curb line of Jori Lane extending 105 feet westerly therefrom.

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F. Along Cedar Knolls Road, westbound on the northerly side thereof at:

- i. Jori Lane - Far Side
Beginning at the prolongation of the westerly curb line of Jori Lane and extending 100 feet westerly therefrom.

Section 2. That New Jersey Transit shall be responsible for the erection of all necessary bus stop signs and shall alert operators of the new bus stops.

Section 3. That the Police Department will enforce all Title 39 traffic regulations governing the bus stop locations in order to ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists.

Section 4. That certified copies of this resolution shall be transmitted to New Jersey Transit's Bus Stop & Shelter Programs' Field Representative, the Chief of Police and Township Engineer for reference and action purposes.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

Section 6. In case, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the law.
