

ORDINANCE NO. 17-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 14-2008 AND CHAPTER 61 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP ENTITLED SALARIES AND COMPENSATION; PERSONNEL POLICIES WHICH ORDINANCE AND CHAPTER ESTABLISHES REGULATIONS AND RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER BY PROVIDING A SALARY FOR THE NEW PART-TIME CIVILIAN DARE/SAFE SCHOOLS RESOURCE SPECIALIST AND SALARY RANGE FOR THE SEASONAL DIRECTOR OF THE SUMMER PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Township Committee intends to hire a part-time civilian DARE/Safe Schools Resource Specialist and amend the hourly wage range for the Department of Recreation and Park Administration’s seasonal Director of the Summer Program; and

WHEREAS, in this regard, it is the desire of the Township Committee to amend and supplement Salary Ordinance No. 14-2008 and Chapter 61 of the Code of the Township entitled Salaries and Compensation; Personnel Policies in order to provide for the salary and hourly wage range for the positions described above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Section 1. of the above entitled Ordinance is hereby amended and supplemented to include the following job position and title:

“15. Drug Abuse and Resistance Education (DARE)/Safe Schools Resource Specialist (SSRS).....\$ 41,600.00
(Part-Time position working ten (10) months a year)

Section 2. Section 7. Of the above entitled Ordinance is hereby amended and supplemented to include a new salary range for the position set forth below:

“17. Director/Summer Program.....\$21.00 to \$23.00 /Hr.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

Section 4. In case, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
