

ORDINANCE NO. 19-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AUTHORIZING THE RESURFACING OF A PORTION OF BEE MEADOW PARKWAY FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH REYNOLDS AVENUE TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH HILLARY COURT IN THE WHIPPANY SECTION OF THE TOWNSHIP AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$365,000.00 FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT FROM THE YEAR 2011 CURRENT FUND BUDGET AND THE NEW JERSEY TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND AUTHORITY ACT AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION AND INSTALLATION OF AN ELECTRONIC SLIDING SECURITY GATE FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS GARAGE AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$25,000.00 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF 2011 AND ALL PRIOR YEARS TO FUND THE ACQUISITION AND INSTALLATION

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Township of Hanover to resurface a portion of Bee Meadow Parkway from its intersection with Reynolds Avenue to its intersection with Hillary Court in the Whippany section of the Township; and

WHEREAS, due to its deteriorating condition, and in order to ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists, it is the desire of the Township Committee to resurface a portion of Bee Meadow Parkway from Reynolds Avenue to its intersection with Hillary Court; and

WHEREAS, funds for the resurfacing of Bee Meadow Parkway will be made available through the Road Construction and Reconstruction Account of the Township's calendar year 2011 Current Fund Budget, and a grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation's fiscal year 2011 Municipal Aid Program through the New Jersey Transportation Trust Fund Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, the resurfacing of a portion of Bee Meadow Parkway will include milling, a new asphalt riding surface, drainage modifications, and other related improvements; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of securing the Township's Public Works Garage and the outside storage of vehicles and equipment at the facility after normal business hours and on weekends, it is the intention of the Township Committee to authorize the acquisition and installation of an electronic sliding security gate; and

WHEREAS, funds for the electronic sliding security gate have been allocated and are available in the Township's 2011 Capital Improvement Fund and all prior years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The resurfacing of a portion of Bee Meadow Parkway from its intersection with Reynolds Avenue to its intersection with Hillary Court is hereby authorized. The Township Engineer and Assistant Township Engineer are further authorized and directed to prepare the specifications, supplementary specifications and drawings for the resurfacing of a portion of Bee Meadow Parkway and to publicly advertise and receive sealed competitive bids, all in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. The resurfacing project shall include milling, a new asphalt riding surface, drainage modifications, and other related improvements.

Section 2. The estimated total cost of the resurfacing of a portion of Bee Meadow Parkway is \$365,000.00.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated for the purposes set forth in Section 1. of the Ordinance, the sum of \$365,000.00 from the following accounts set forth below:

1. Year 2011 Current Fund Budget -
Road Construction & Reconstruction

2. The New Jersey Transportation
Trust Fund Authority Act for
Fiscal Year 2011..... \$120,000.00

Section 4. The acquisition and installation of an electronic sliding security gate to secure the Township's Public Works Garage located at 25 North Jefferson Road in the Whippany Section of the Township is hereby authorized. Pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., and depending on the estimated cost for the acquisition and installation of the electronic sliding security gate including all related appurtenances, the Township Engineer and Assistant Township Engineer are further authorized and directed to advertise for the receipt of sealed competitive bids, or, obtain written proposals and quotations and/or utilize the services of vendors through the Morris County or Somerset County Cooperative Pricing Councils or utilize a current and valid New Jersey State Contract(s) for the acquisition described herein.

Section 5. For the acquisition and installation of the electronic sliding security gate set forth in Section 4. above, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$25,000.00 from the 2011 Capital Improvement Fund Budget and all prior years.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
