

ORDINANCE NO. 21-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 120-1. ENTITLED "APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF MAP." UNDER ARTICLE I ENTITLED "DRUG-FREE SCHOOL ZONES". AS SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 120 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP ENTITLED DRUGS AND DRUG PARAPHERNALIA. WITH THE INCLUSION OF A NEW SECTION 120-1.

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7, the Township is required to prepare and maintain a "Drug-Free School Zone Map" as an official finding and record of the location and areas within the Township of Hanover of property which is used for school purposes and which is owned by, or leased to any elementary or secondary school or school board, and of the areas on or within 1,000 feet of such school property; and

WHEREAS, at the request of the Police Department, the Township's Engineering Department has updated the Drug-Free School Zone Map in order to include the Abundant Life School located on South Jefferson Road in the Whippany Section of the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Section 120-1. Entitled "Approval and Adoption of Map". under Article I entitled "Drug-Free School Zones." as set forth in Chapter 120 of the Code of the Township entitled "Drugs and Drug Paraphernalia". is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following new paragraph is inserted in its place:

"Section 120-1. In accordance with and pursuant to the authority of P.L. 1988, c.44 (N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7), the Drug-Free School Zone Map prepared on or about March 2, 1988, and revised on or about November 1, 1999 and April, 2011 by the Township Engineer, and reviewed and approved by the Hanover Township Police Department, is hereby further approved and adopted as an official finding and record of the location and areas within the Township of property which is used for school purposes and which is owned by, or leased to any elementary or

secondary school or school board, and of the areas on or within 1,000 feet of such school property.”

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

Section 3. In case, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the law.
