

## ORDINANCE NO. 22-11

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF FIFTY (50) GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM UNITS FOR THE TOWNSHIP'S MOTOR VEHICLE FLEET AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$18,200.00 FROM THE TOWNSHIP'S 2011 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND ALL PRIOR YEARS FOR THE FINANCING OF THE PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, in order to improve and enhance operational efficiency and productivity in the management of its motor vehicle fleet, it is the intention of the Township to purchase fifty (50) Global Positioning System (GPS) tracking units for installation in its vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township believes that the GPS fleet tracking units offer distinct benefits among which are: monitoring the hours of vehicle use, in terms of location and speed; helping reduce fuel costs; improving driver safety behavior and increasing fleet security.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

**Section 1.** The Township Committee hereby authorizes the purchase and installation of fifty (50) Global Positioning System tracking units which units shall be installed in fifty (50) Township motor vehicles for the purpose of monitoring and tracking vehicle usage. In accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., the Business Administrator/Township Clerk and Chief Municipal Finance Officer are further authorized and directed to obtain written quotations for the purchase of the Global Positioning System tracking units including prices related to installation, employee training and monthly air time usage.

**Section 2.** The governing body further authorizes the appropriation of \$18,200.00 from the 2011 Capital Improvement Fund and all prior years to underwrite those costs associated with the purchase and installation of the hardware; namely, the Global Positioning System tracking equipment described in Section 1. above, including the cost related to training employees in the use of the GPS devices.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
