

ORDINANCE NO. 29-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 32-10 ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) NEW STRAIGHT FRAME 31 CUBIC YARD AUTOMATED SANITATION TRUCK EQUIPPED WITH AN ARTICULATED ARM PLUS ALL RELATED EQUIPMENT AND 1,200 TRASH CONTAINERS IN VARIOUS SIZES FOR THE TOWNSHIP’S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND FURTHER APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$375,000.00 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF 2010 AND ALL PRIOR YEARS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF THE VEHICLE AND CONTAINERS” WITH THE APPROPRIATION OF AN ADDITIONAL \$90,000.00 FROM THE 2011 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE TRASH CONTAINERS

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2011, the Township’s Bid Reception Committee received and opened one (1) sealed competitive bid from **Beyer Brothers Corporation** for the purchase of one (1) new 31 cubic yard automated sanitation collection truck with an articulated arm plus all related equipment together with various bid options; and

WHEREAS, one of the bid options pertains to the purchase of either sixty (60) gallon or ninety-five (95) gallon sanitation containers which would be owned by the Township; and

WHEREAS, each residential household would be assigned one (1) container in order to place its sanitation; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Public Works, Buildings and Grounds and Park Maintenance Department is recommending the purchase of a combination of sixty (60) gallon and ninety-five (95) gallon containers not to exceed a total quantity of 2,000; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department estimates that it initially requires approximately 1,200 sixty (60) gallon and ninety-five (95) gallon sanitation containers for those homeowners who will be serviced by the new automated sanitation collection truck; and

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2011, the Township received and opened one (1) sealed competitive bid from **Beyer Brothers Corporation** which bid included two options; namely, Option 1, the purchase of sixty (60) gallon Schaefer Universal Containers at \$45.92 each; and Option 2, the purchase of ninety-five (95) gallon Schaefer Universal Containers at \$54.42 each; and

WHEREAS, although the sixty (60) gallon and ninety-five (95) gallon containers are only available in lots of 2,000 each, Sanitation Equipment Corporation, the sub-contractor under bid to provide the containers has agreed to permit the Township to purchase a combination of both container sizes; and

WHEREAS, based on the unit prices set forth in the bid, the Township will be able to purchase a combined total quantity of 2,000 sixty (60) gallon and ninety-five (95) gallon Schaefer Universal Containers; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 32-10, adopted by the Township Committee on December 9, 2010, appropriated the sum of \$375,000.00 for the purchase of one (1) new 31-cubic yard automated sanitation truck equipped with an articulated arm and the purchase of 1,200 sanitation containers; and

WHEREAS, after carefully examining the costs associated with the purchase of the 31 cubic yard automated sanitation truck plus all related equipment, the Township has determined that the appropriation of \$375,000.00 is only sufficient to cover the cost of purchasing the 31 cubic yard automated sanitation truck and not enough to purchase a combination of 2,000 sixty (60) gallon and ninety-five (95) gallon sanitation containers; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Township Committee to amend and supplement Ordinance No. 32-10 with the appropriation of an additional \$90,000.00 in order to provide sufficient funds for the purchase of a combined total of 2,000 units of

sixty (60) gallon and ninety-five (95) gallon Schaefer Universal Containers, as part of the contract award to **Beyer Brothers Corporation** for the purchase of one (1) new 31-cubic yard automated sanitation truck equipped with an articulated arm plus all related equipment and options.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Section 1. of Ordinance No. 32-10 is hereby amended and supplemented with the inclusion of the following new sentences:

“The governing body hereby authorizes the purchase of a combined total of 2,000 sixty (60) gallon and ninety-five (95) gallon Schaefer Universal Containers at a cost of \$45.92 and \$54.42 per container respectively from **Beyer Brothers Corporation**, all in accordance with the sealed competitive bid proposal submitted by **Beyer Brothers** to the Township’s Bid Reception Committee on August 30, 2011. The 2,000 sixty (60) gallon and ninety-five (95) gallon containers will be owned by the Township of Hanover.

Each residential household along the routes to be serviced by the new 31-cubic yard automated sanitation truck will be assigned either one (1) sixty (60) gallon container or one (1) ninety-five (95) gallon sanitation container. If a container is damaged and rendered unusable because it is not properly maintained by the household, the cost for a replacement container shall be borne by the property owner or renter whichever the case may be.”

Section 2. Section 3. of Ordinance No. 32-10 is hereby amended and supplement with the appropriation of an additional \$90,000.00 from the 2011 Capital Improvement Fund and all prior years for the financing of sixty (60) gallon and ninety-five (95) gallon sanitation containers for a combined total of 2,000 units as described in Section 1. above.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
