

**ORDINANCE NO. 20-12**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROLLER CABINET AND ALL RELATED CONTROLLER EQUIPMENT TO BE INSTALLED AT THE INTERSECTION OF TROY HILLS ROAD AND HIGHLAND AVENUE AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$16,000.00 FOR SAID IMPROVEMENT FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF 2012 AND ALL PRIOR YEARS**

**WHEREAS**, Jersey Central Power and Light Company has notified the Township of Hanover that an unsafe and/or deteriorated condition exists with the traffic controller equipment at the intersection of Troy Hills Road and Highland Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, because the traffic controller is old and in a state of deterioration, it is necessary for the Township to replace the traffic controller cabinet and interior equipment in the interest of public safety.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

**Section 1.** The Township Committee hereby authorizes the Engineering Department to remove and replace the existing traffic controller cabinet and all related controller equipment at the intersection of Troy Hills Road and Highland Avenue.

**Section 2.** In accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6.1, the Township Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to solicit written competitive quotations in obtaining the following equipment and services for the replacement of the existing controller cabinet at the intersection of Troy Hills Road and Highland Avenue:

1. The removal of the existing controller cabinet;
2. The purchase and installation of all new equipment as follows: M-36 Stretch Controller Cabinet with load switches, a Econolite Controller, a 12 channel conflict monitor, a JCP&L meter pan, a 2-circuit panel with breakers, a GFC1 receptacle with box and weather proof cover.

**Section 3.** The governing body further authorizes the appropriation of \$16,000.00 from the 2012 Capital Improvement Fund and all prior years for the procurement of services in the removal of the existing controller described in Section 1. above and the purchase and installation of a new controller cabinet and all related equipment and appurtenances as described in Section 2. above.

**Section 4.** The Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
