

ORDINANCE NO. 9-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AUTHORIZING THE FOLLOWING IMPROVEMENTS AT THE BEE MEADOW SWIMMING POOL FACILITY: (1) REPAIR TO THE PERIMETER EDGE DECK OF THE POOL; AND (2) REROOFING OF THE BEE MEADOW POOL MAINTENANCE BUILDING AND FURTHER APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$115,000.00 FOR THE FINANCING OF BOTH PROJECTS THROUGH THE SWIMMING POOL ENTERPRISE FUND CAPITAL ACCOUNT OF 2012 AND ALL PRIOR YEARS

WHEREAS, the continual maintenance and improvement to the Bee Meadow Swimming Pool infrastructure is essential in order to maintain its integrity and reliability as a fully functional and operational amenity for the benefit of pool members; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide the proper maintenance to keep the pool facility in good condition, it is necessary to perform essential repairs to the perimeter edge of the deck pool and reroofing the Pool's Maintenance Building; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the recommendations of the Township Engineer, it is the intention of the governing body to authorize the needed maintenance work and further appropriate funds through the Swimming Pool Enterprise Funds' 2012 Capital Account and all prior years for the financing of the projects described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey:

Section 1. The following improvement repairs to the Bee Meadow Swimming Pool and the Pool Maintenance Building are hereby authorized:

- A. The removal of the existing tile, mud bed and loose concrete and the replacement of the existing surface with a new surface along the perimeter edge deck of the Bee Meadow Swimming Pool; and
- B. The removal of the existing roof and roof deck and the installation of a new EPDM membrane roofing system for the Pool Maintenance Building.

The Township Engineer and Assistant Engineer are authorized and directed to prepare the necessary plans, specifications, supplementary specifications and drawings for the two (2) projects described above and to publicly advertise and receive sealed competitive bids, all in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

Section 2. The following funds are hereby appropriated from the Swimming Pool Enterprise Funds' 2012 Capital Account and all prior years for the financing of the following projects:

- A. The sum of \$55,000.00 is authorized and appropriated for the performance of the perimeter edge deck repair project as described in **Section 1. A.** above; and
- B. The sum of \$60,000.00 is authorized and appropriated for the reroofing of the Bee Meadow Swimming Pool Maintenance Building as described in **Section 1. B.** above.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
