

ORDINANCE NO. 26-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ENGINEER TO RETAIN THE SERVICES OF A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER LICENSED BY THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO PREPARE DESIGN DRAWINGS, CONSTRUCTION PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND ON-SITE CONSTRUCTION OBSERVATION SERVICES IN MODIFYING AND REPLACING THREE (3) OVERHEAD GARAGE DOORS AT THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT GARAGE, AUTHORIZING THE MODIFICATION AND REPLACEMENT OF THE THREE (3) OVERHEAD DOORS AND FURTHER APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$80,000.00 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF 2013 AND ALL PRIOR YEARS FOR THE FINANCING OF THE PROJECT DESCRIBED HEREIN

WHEREAS, the Township is in the process of replacing some of its conventional rear load sanitation vehicles with state of the art 31-cubic yard automated sanitation trucks with right hand articulated arms; and

WHEREAS, in order to accommodate the height of the new vehicles, it is necessary to modify and replace three (3) existing overhead garage doors at the Public Works Department Garage located at 25 North Jefferson Road; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Township Committee to authorize the Township Engineer to retain the services of a professional engineer, licensed by the State of New Jersey for the purpose of preparing design drawings, construction plans, specifications and on-site construction observation services related to replacing the overhead garage doors, as well as authorize the Township Engineer to advertise for the receipt of sealed competitive bids to modify and replace three (3) existing overhead doors at the Public Works Department Garage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The Township Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to retain the services of a professional engineer, licensed by the State of New Jersey, for the purpose of preparing design drawings, construction plans, specifications and on-site

observation services related to the modification and replacement of three (3) existing overhead doors at Public Works Department Garage.

Section 2. In accordance with the drawings, plans and specifications to be prepared by the licensed professional engineer, the Township Engineer is further authorized and directed to advertise for the receipt of sealed competitive bids pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. for the modification and replacement of three (3) overhead garage doors at the Public Works Department Garage in order to accommodate the additional height of the new automated sanitation trucks.

Section 3. For the financing of the engineering services and replacement of the overhead garage doors described in Sections 1. and 2. above, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$80,000.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund of 2013 and all prior years.

Section 4. The publication and advertisement costs associated with the hiring of a licensed professional engineer including the public notice to bidders shall be charged to this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
