

ORDINANCE NO. 20-2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 15-15 WHICH ESTABLISHED A NEW CHAPTER 194 ENTITLED REGULATIONS GOVERNING UNATTENDED CHILDREN AND ANIMALS IN MOTOR VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Township Committee adopted Ordinance No. 15-15 on June 11, 2015 which Ordinance established a new Chapter 194 entitled Regulations Governing Unattended Children and Animals in Motor Vehicles; and

WHEREAS, a need exists to clarify the intent and meaning of paragraphs d. and c. under §194-1A. and §194-2. of Chapter 194.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph d. under §194-1A. entitled “Unattended Children” is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

“d. All owners of shopping malls, strip malls or other shopping facilities with contiguous parking areas are hereby required to post signs in the parking areas noting that, pursuant to this Ordinance, any parent, guardian, or other responsible person, may be subject to punishment for leaving children unattended.”

Section 2. Paragraph d. under §194-2B. entitled “Unattended Animals” is hereby amended and supplemented:

“d. All owners of shopping malls, strip malls or other shopping facilities with contiguous parking areas are hereby required to post signs in the parking areas noting that, pursuant to this Ordinance, any owner or other person having custody of an animal, may be subject to punishment for leaving a pet unattended in a vehicle.”

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

Section 4. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the law.


